



Our province centers and city centers were created to financially support our social services. By having programs like subsidized daily English classes, AHHA Education Cambodia can further expand or start new projects that would give underserved communities education or social services which are either free or at a nominal fee.

Province and City Centers



Our province and city centers not only function as an education provider, but also function as a central point where different community services are organized. Managers and teachers often organize community service activities such as cleaning up the community, helping neighbors, road patch works and more. The centers are also used to hold concerts and other community events.

BOARDING PROGRAMS



20 MONTH BOARDING PROGRAM

Youths aged from 16-29 go through 20 months of holistic education training in employment and life skills. Students study subjects such as; Language, IT, Character, Leadership, Teaching, Management, Accounting etc. As part of their practical training, students get the opportunity to become trainee teacher and carry out other responsibilities. 99% of our graduates have been able to attain good employment, earning double the starting salary.



2ND HOME PROGRAM

Our 2nd home program provides a solution to many Cambodians who lack access to schools by providing boarding facilities at our centers where they can go to a nearby public school while at the same time, attending our educational programs. They no longer have to walk a few hours to get to a nearby school.



3 MONTH VACATION PROGRAM

The 3-Month Vacation program is offered to students of any age who would like to study during the public school vacation period. The program is similar to the first 2 semesters of our 20-month boarding program. Students who complete the English course successfully, are rewarded with a Level-1 or Level 2 Certificate.



NON-BOARDING PROGRAMS



Subsidized Daily Classes

Subsidized daily classes are provided in our province centers and our city center. There we provide quality English and IT education. The courses are offered to school-going youths, university students and company employees who want to learn English or IT. The daily classes are carried out from Monday until Friday.



Free Children Daily Classes

AHHA Education Cambodia's free children classes teaches children the English language, creativity, compassion and moral values in a fun way. Early interaction with peers helps them to develop social skills at a young age. Besides that, our classes are focused in developing a strong foundation in the child's character and in nurturing a child's potential.



Partner Program Daily Classes

Our partner program is a partnership between AHHA Education Cambodia and various primary and/or secondary schools, pagodas, hospitals, prisons or other places where education is needed. We provide our educational programs (mainly English) for 1-2 hours a day. Classes are given for free and students enjoy the extra support they are getting from our programs.



TRANSFER OF SKILLS PROGRAM



Good Citizen Program

(Local Volunteer Program)

This program is the first building stepping stone to become a well-experienced teacher, manager and leader in the field of social service and community development. Students take on a range of responsibilities from being teachers to being in charge of the school operations, the school kitchen, school logistics and more. They also practice different soft skills and continue to develop their AHHA skills.



Bring Back Home Program

(Exchange Program)

Our Bring Back Home Program is a powerful educational program where outstanding volunteers get a 2 year placement in one of our overseas operations; Laos or Timor-Leste. After getting a lot of experience and having developed many skills, the volunteers return to Cambodia and transfer their gained knowledge and skills to Cambodian youths for another 6 months.



Leadership Hand-over Program

(Manage a center >> Own a center)

In this program, volunteers will be learning all the skills which are part of Big Teacher's NGO Life[®] and NGO Set-up[®] Program. During this program, volunteers will run a province center under supervision of the management of AHHA. Once they have developed all the necessary skills, we will transfer the ownership of the center to the managers so that they can continue to run the center independently.

STATISTICS / PROBLEM

Only 45.2 % of Cambodians are enrolled for high school education and only 13.1 % of Cambodians attain tertiary education.

The drop-out rate also gets high when it comes to secondary education, reaching 21 percent in lower secondary in 2014. Although rural and the poorest youth have an improved opportunity to enter higher grades, their rate of school enrolment is still low compared to urban and affluent youth.

A more recent INSEAD 2018 Global Talent Competitiveness index indicates that out of 119 countries, Cambodia is ranked at the 113th place when it comes to vocational and technical skills (like IT).

With the future integration of the ASEAN countries, this provides massive potential growth for the economy, but the low percentages of Cambodians' educational attainment puts them at a serious disadvantage as they face competition by more skilled human resources from other ASEAN countries. There is a great urgency for education and development.

SUPPORT

We invite you to partner with us in this most great opportunity to bring IT education to underserved youths in Cambodia. Through your support we would like to buy 50 computers to teach 250 students IT on a daily base in our main center. The cost of 1 computer is USD 250. Therefore, we need USD 12,500 to buy 50 computers to run our activities in our main center, located in Phnom Penh.

Through AHHA Cambodia, I have been very privileged to be involved in this mission of building and impacting the lives of the underprivileged. For 20 years, my team and I have labored to bring education to Cambodians and the journey has definitely been both a challenging and fulfilling one.
